



Hamblin Tops DEKALB SuperLeague at 8-1

Draw 8 & 9, the final two round robin draws in the DEKALB Super League, were played Monday evening in Morden. David Hamblin & his Morris team won two games to improve their league leading record to 8-1. Randy Neufeld (La Salle) won a pair to lock down second place with a 7-2 record and Dean North (Carman) won two to move into a third place tie with Ryan Hyde (Portage) and Rob Ramage (Baldur). Both Hyde & Ramage split their two games in Morden.

WEEK 4: Hamblin Wins 2, Improves to 6-1 in DEKALB SuperLeague - With a pair of wins Thursday in Portage, David Hamblin's Morris team moved into first place in the standings in the DEKALB Super League. Hamblin defeated Ryan Hyde-Portage 7-5 in an extra end and Dean North-Carman 7-1 to improve to 6-1. A split games for Ryan Hyde and Randy Neufeld moved both of their records to 5-2. Rob Ramage won a pair to improve to 5-2, as well.

WEEK 3: Hamblin Wins 2, Joins Neufeld, Ryan Hyde at 4-1 in DEKALB Super League - David Hamblin won a pair of games (6-3 over Tom Hyde & 5-4 over Randy Neufeld) to move into a first place in the DEKALB SuperLeague after the 4th and 5th games in Portage Thursday. Hamblin's record is now 4-1, tied with Neufeld who defeated Dean North on the opening draw. Also at 4-1 is Ryan Hyde, who also split the Portage double-header (5-3 over Rob Fleming & a loss 6-3 to Rob Ramage).

WEEK 2: Neufeld, Ryan Hyde 3-0 - : Four teams won a pair of games on the first DEKALB SuperLeague double-header night Thursday in Carman. Randy Neufeld-LaSalle (over Tom Hyde 7-0 and Rob Findlay 8-1) and Ryan Hyde-Portage (over Dean North 4-3 and Findlay 6-5) now have 3-0 records while three more have 2-1 records. David Hamblin-Morris (6-3 over Allan Gitzel & 8-1 over Bob Bartley) and Rob Fleming-Morden (7-4 over Bartley and 4-3 over Rob Ramage) won two to improve to 2-1 and Dean North's Carman team (8-6 over Ramage and 4-3 loss to R. Hyde) split the double header to end the evening at 2-1, as well.
